Anya Pogorelova is the Director of Bands at Washburn University where she teaches courses in music education, conducting, and directs the Marching Ichabods, University Band, and the Washburn Wind Ensemble. Prior to joining the music faculty at Washburn, Anya taught at the middle school, high school, and collegiate level in Saskatchewan, Georgia, and Missouri. As a passionate advocate for access to music education for all, Anya is the founder of the Topeka New Horizons Band and previously served as the assistant director of the Roeland Park New Horizons Band.

She maintains an active schedule as a clinician and guest conductor throughout the country and is consistently inspired by the next generation of young musicians. Most recently, Anya was selected as the winner of The American Prize in Conducting, college/university wind ensemble division. She is a proud alumna of the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory (DMA, MM), Georgia State University (MM), and the University of Saskatchewan (BM Hons, BEd).

Caroline Hand, 56A Band


Caroline Hand believes in the ability of ensemble music making to create connections among student musicians and audiences alike, and searches for ways to enhance these bonds. Dr. Hand has the opportunity to facilitate these connections by conducting the Symphony Band, teaching conducting courses for undergraduate and graduate students, and visiting schools in the region.



Dr. Hand is in demand as a guest conductor across the region and nation with numerous honor band appearances, most recently as the guest conductor for TMEA and ATSSB Region 21 clinics in Texas. An avid supporter of community engagement through music, Dr. Hand spearheaded the Sensory Friendly Concert Series in the University of Oklahoma School of Music. She has been selected to present on her innovative and engaged teaching methods such as the Orpheus Project and facilitating high impact collaborations with university music ensembles. She is also pursuing research and study of works for wind band by female composers and is dedicated to well-rounded programming to expose her students to a wide array of styles, composers, and historical periods all with the aim of communicating to the listener.

Dr. Hand previously held the position of associate director of bands at Ball State University and taught public school in Mountain Home, AR and Tyler, TX ISD. She earned degrees from the University of Minnesota (DMA conducting), Baylor University (MM band conducting), and Oklahoma State University (BME).





Russ Pieken, Orchestra

In 2024, Russ Pieken co-founded AD ASTRA YOUTH ORCHESTRA KANSAS CITY. In less than two years, this cutting-edge program has welcomed over 180 students in grades 5-college level string players. Ad Astra musicians hail from all parts of the Kansas City area, from both sides of the state line. Ad Astra is developing a caring community where young musicians grow, shine, create beauty, and thrive. Our goal is for each member to find joy in performing great music and taking part in meaning performances with their peers. This mirrors Kansas City's spirit of creativity, support, kindness, humility, pride, and heart.

Ad Astra members have collaborated and performed with professional and community musicians. The list includes Grammy-nominated organist/pianist Jan Kraybill, KNPR Host/Violinist Destiny Mermagen, and Kansas City Symphony Concertmaster Jun Iwasaki. In 2024, Ad Astra was the featured performance group for the Annual Kansas City Chamber of Commerce Awards Dinner and Banquet. Ad Astra is proud to have been selected/invited to perform at the 2026 KMEA Conference in Wichita. June of 2026 will see Ad Astra take part in the Vienna Masterworks Residency in New York City which will culminate with their debut performance in Carnegie Hall.

Mr. Pieken has a Bachelor's degree in Music Education and Viola Performance from UMKC, a Master's degree in Education from Baker University, and has continued studies at the Vandercook College of Music in Chicago.
